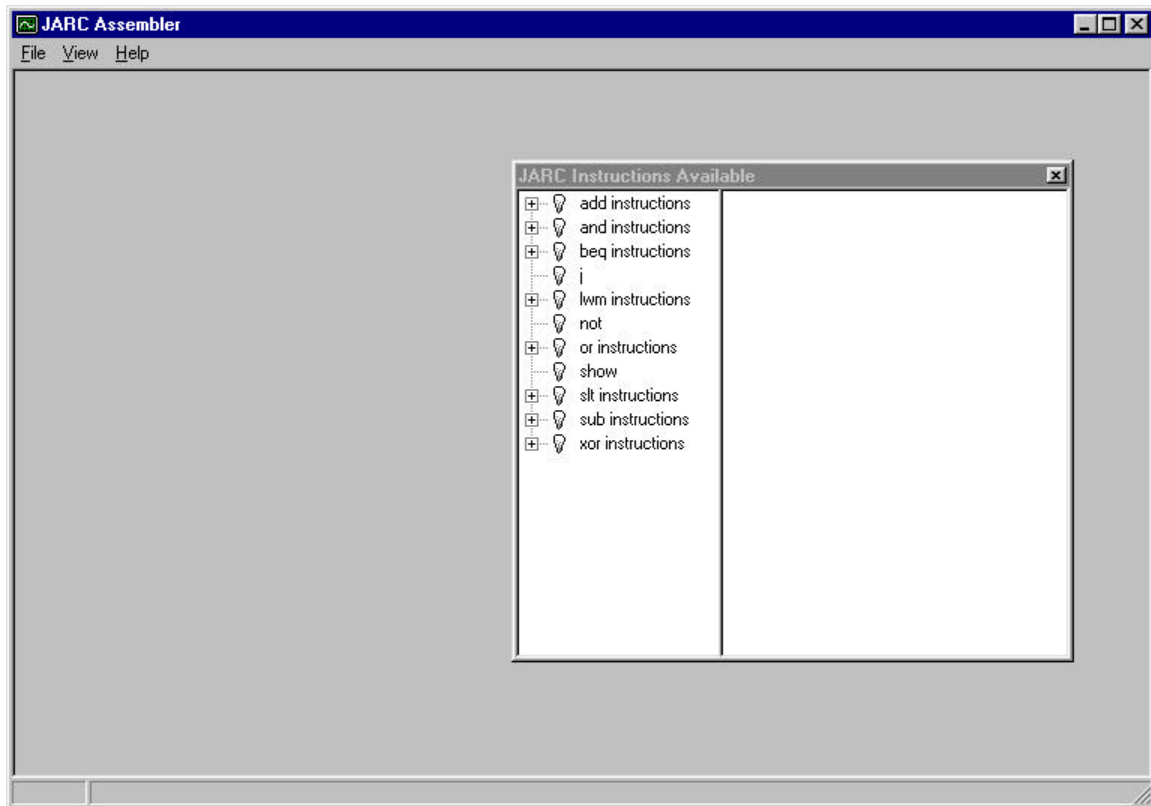
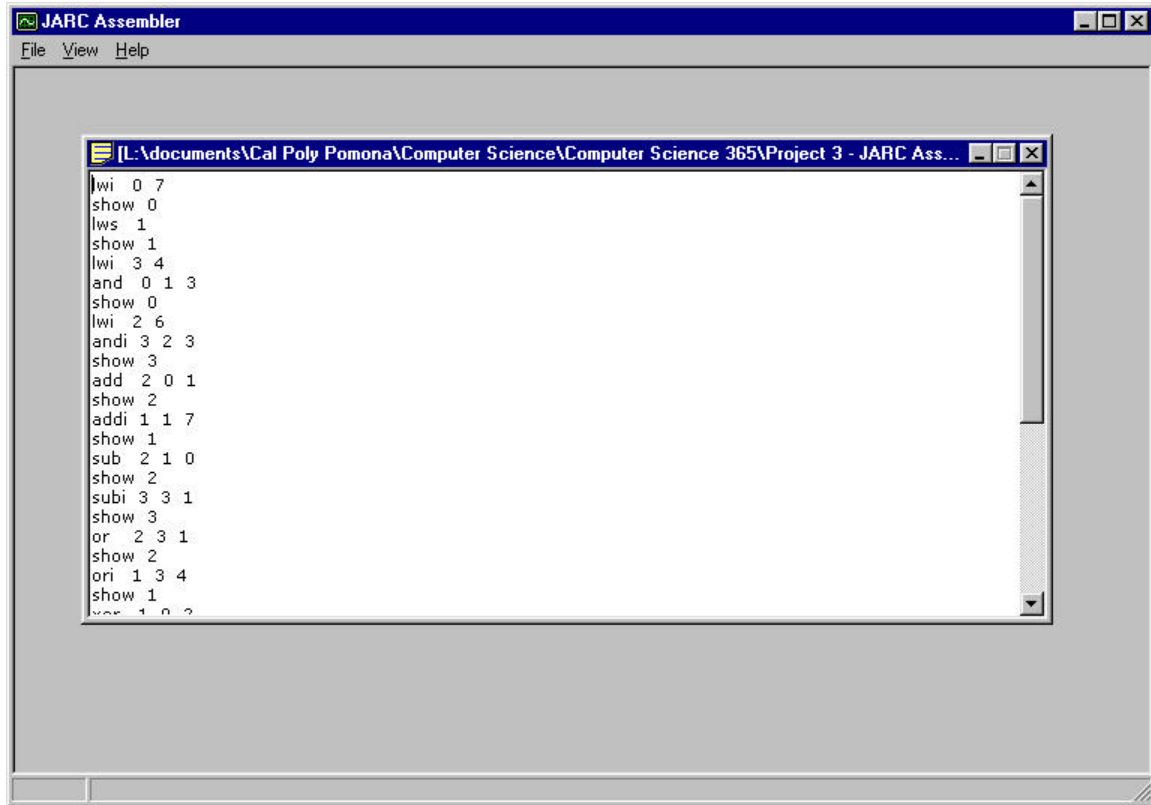


Welcome to JARC Assembler

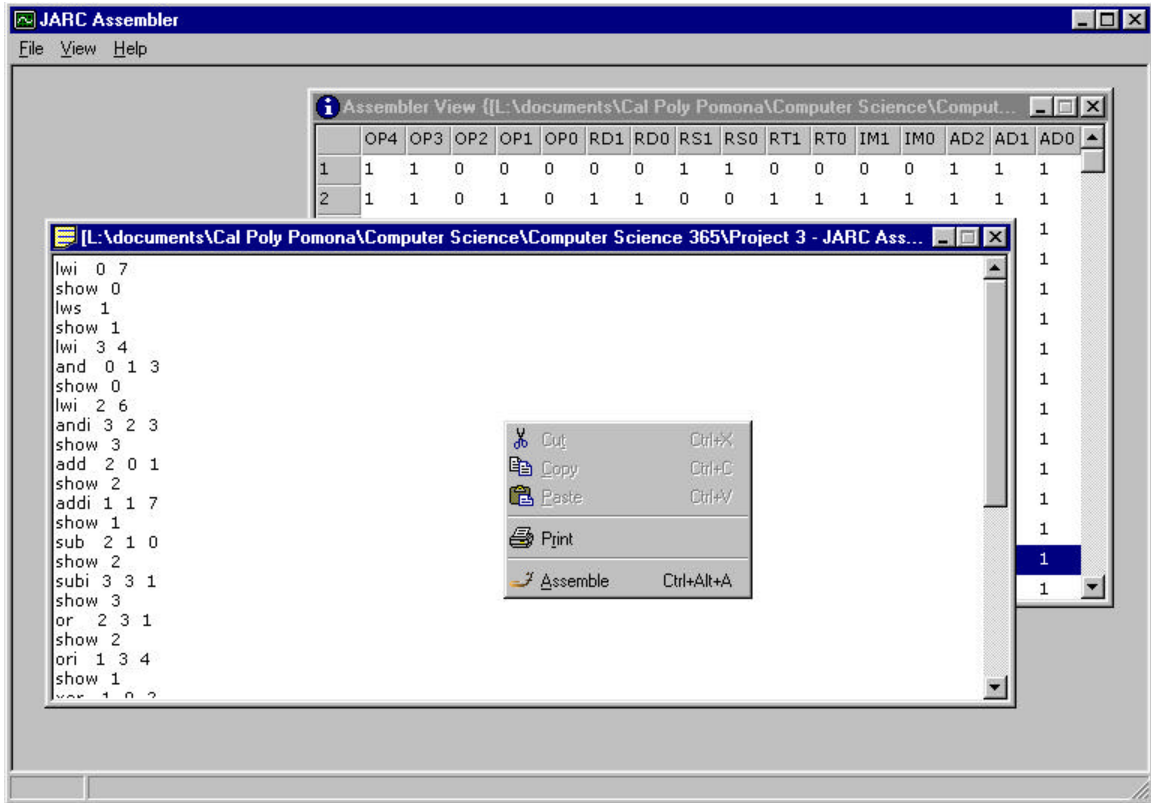
Here are a few screenshots of the program. The screenshots displayed are from the Beta 2 of the application.



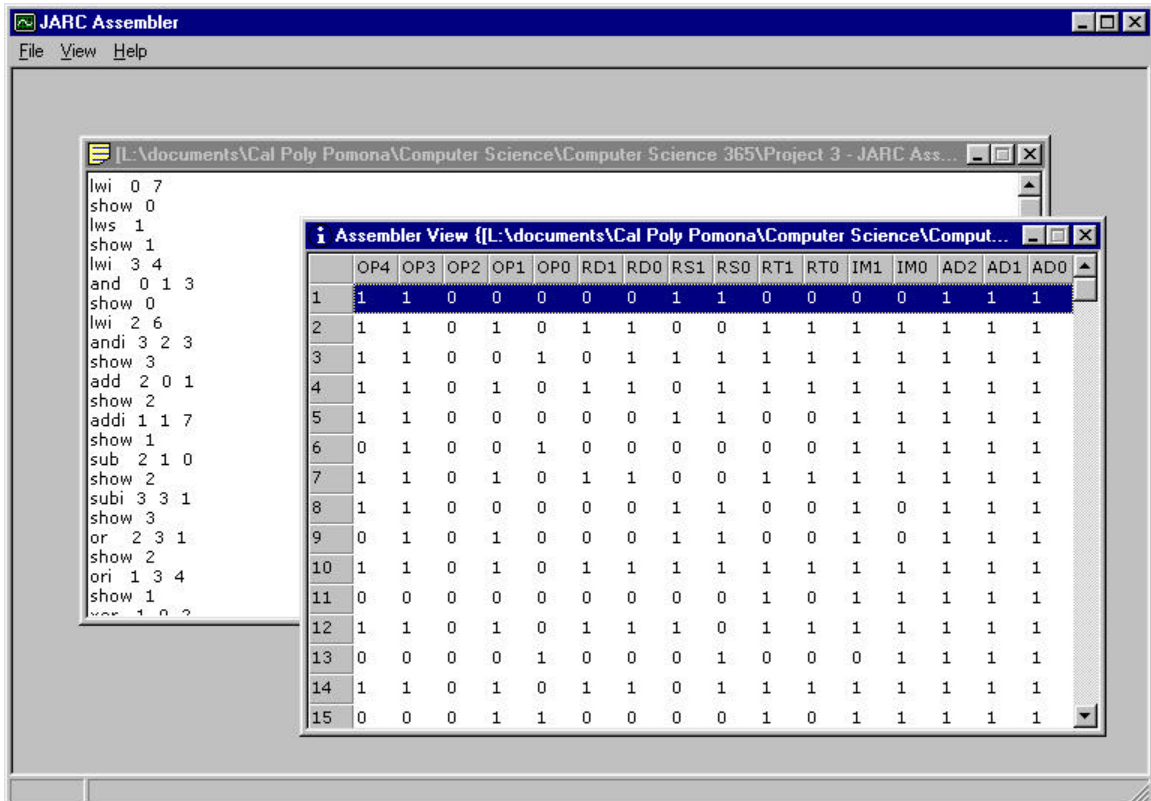

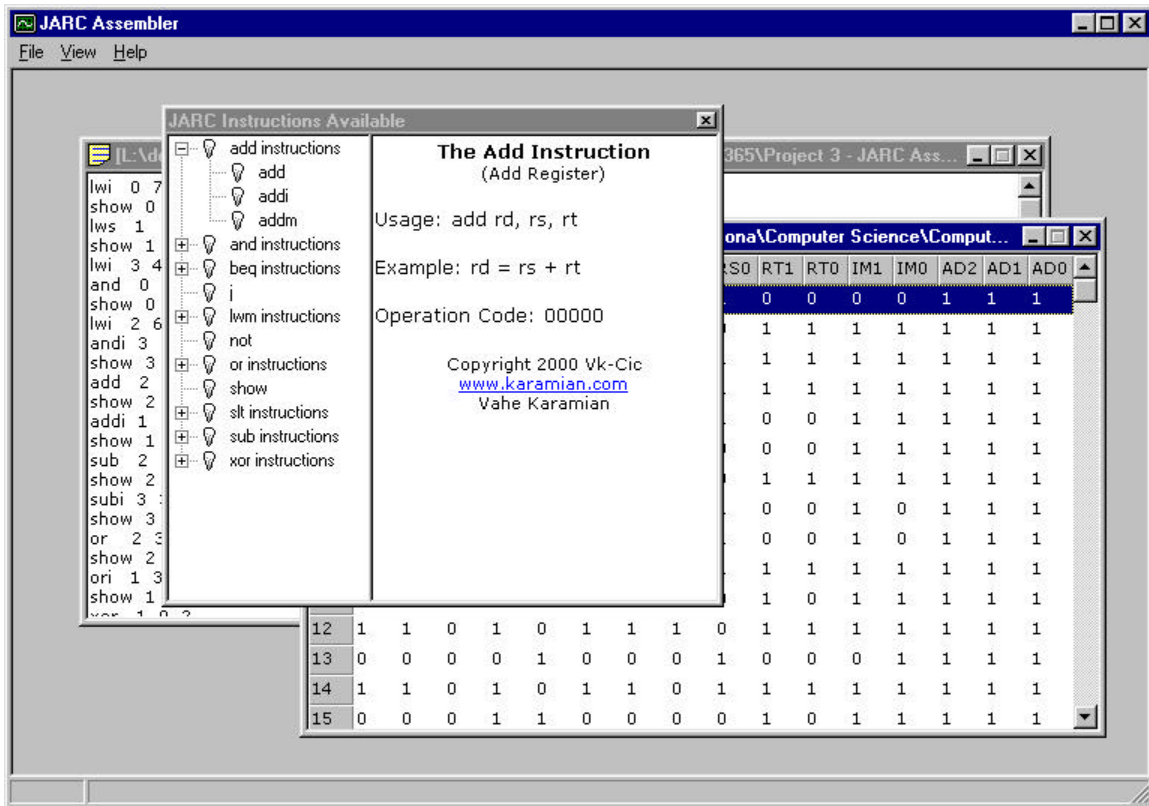

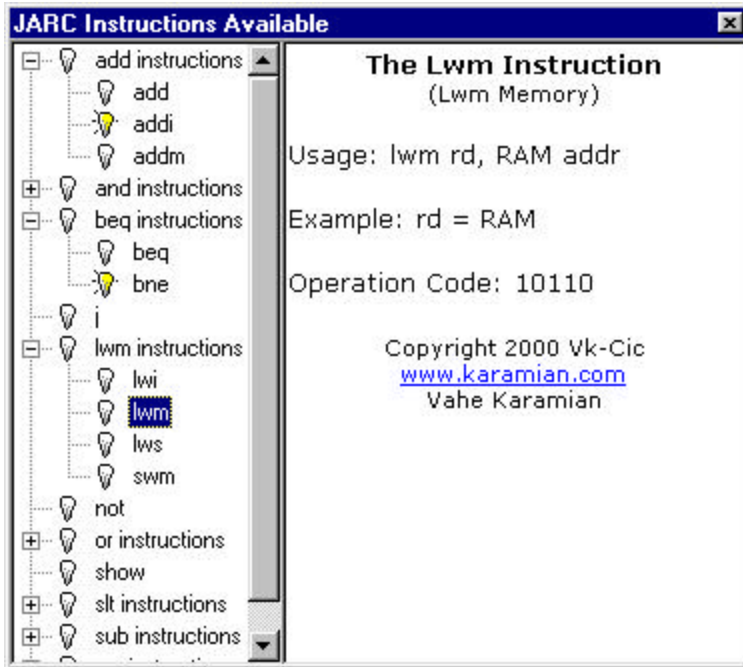
Some of the JARC Editor functions are displayed in the above shot.



Here you see the Assembler view, with the binary code of the program in the editor.

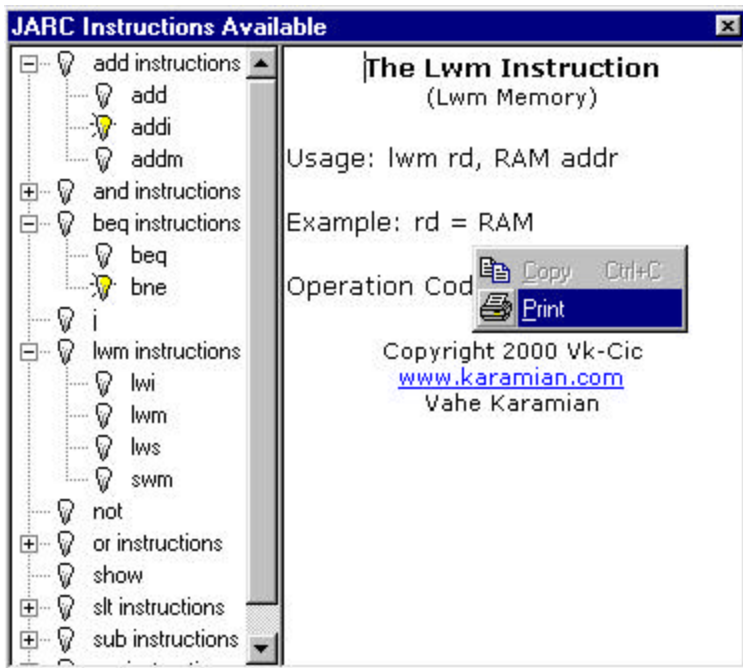
